### **REPORT ON UGC NET COACHING**

The Department of Social Work recognized the importance of preparing the students for the UGC NET and SET exams, which are crucial for pursuing research and teaching careers. During the 2023-24 academic year, we implemented a comprehensive coaching program designed to equip students with the necessary knowledge and skills to excel in these competitive exams.

#### **Program Structure:**

This program offered a dedicated time slot (Wednesdays, 2 PM to 4 PM) for focused learning outside of regular coursework. This flexibility catered to the busy schedules of first and second-year MSW students, attracting a group of 29 participants. The department strategically leveraged its own faculty expertise, ensuring students received instruction from experienced professionals with a deep understanding of the social work field and the demands of the UGC NET and SET exams.

#### **Course Content:**

The program offered a two-pronged approach, addressing both foundational knowledge and social work-specific topics. The General Paper component focused on developing a strong base in:

- ✓ **General Knowledge:** Information about current events and fostering a well-rounded understanding of the world.
- ✓ **Communication Skills:** Questions regarding Communication Skills which is essential for academic success, research pursuits, and classroom teaching.

- ✓ **Mental Ability & Reasoning:** Questions related to critical thinking and problem-solving skills, which are valuable assets in academic exams and future careers.
- ✓ **Research Methodology:** Equipping students with the knowledge of Research Methodology and related questions.
- ✓ **Teaching Aptitude:** Practicing the Aptitude questions related to teaching.

In addition to the General Paper, dedicated classes delved into subjects central to the field of social work. These classes explored:

- ✓ **Contemporary Social Work Issues:** Keeping students up-to-date on evolving social problems and emerging areas of practice.
- ✓ **Casework and other Social Work Methods:** Providing in-depth knowledge of core social work interventions and practices.

### **Enhancing Student Learning:**

The program went beyond lectures by providing participants with printed study materials that served as a valuable reference point throughout their preparation. To gauge student understanding and identify areas for improvement, the program incorporated periodical test papers. This approach allowed students to assess their progress, receive feedback, and refine their study strategies.

### **Overall Impact:**

The UGC NET coaching program offered by the Department of Social Work stands as a commendable initiative. By providing a structured learning environment, comprehensive study materials, and opportunities for self-assessment, the program equipped students with the tools and knowledge to confidently approach the UGC NET and SET exams. This program not only boosted their chances of exam success but also prepared them for potential careers in research and teaching, allowing them to contribute significantly to the field of social work.
