



























































































6. Employability of the Curriculum












6. Employability of the Curriculum

























1. Size of syllabus in term of the load 20 responses















The quality of the subject matter in the Curriculum 45 responses









































The quality of the subject matter in the Curriculum 76 responses








































1. Occupation of the parents:





2. Class of the students




It denotes that 59.3% of the respondents are from second year and 40.7% are from first year.

3. The quality and relevance of the courses included in the Curriculum





4. The quality of the subject matter in the Curriculum





5. Availability of choices [electives] under choice based credit system





6. Inclusion of current development in the curriculum and catering to future needs






