

REPARING and WASTE MANAGEMENT

Blown out fuse are replaced in electronics instruments. Main chord wires are open circuited often. They are replaced. Transformers (step down) in power supplies are often burnt out due to short circuit. So short circuit protection circuits are added with the power supplies. Enough transformers, fuses with different ratings & Main chords are kept sufficiently in laboratory for replacement. Technicians are invited in every year for major servicing.
