Evaluation:







The social work trainee discussed with the agency supervisor and women group coordinator Mrs Usha about the programme. Then the agency supervisor and student discussed about finding a







Mr Britto, Senior treatment supervisor, TBU Edaicode, gave an introduction speech about Elimination of TB by 2025. Then the session was handled to the resource person Dr. Ramesh, Medical officer, MBSS, District TB centre. He gave explanation about prevalence and response, Government schemes and benefits,types of TB, symptoms of TB and treatment of TB. A potentially serious infectious bacterial disease that mainly affects the lungs. The bacteria that cause TB are spread when an infected person coughs or sneezes. Most people infected with the bacteria that cause tuberculosis don't have symptoms do occur, they usually include a cough (sometimes blood-tinged), weight loss, night sweats and fever. Patients with active symptoms will require long course of treatment involving multiple antibiotics. Pulmonary tuberculosis, pleural tuberculosis. Skeletal tuberculosis, brain tuberculosis, Bladder and kidney tuberculosis, joint tuberculosis, gastrointestinal tract tuberculosis and Military tuberculosis. officer. medical Dr.NiceMol Naturopathy, Governmenthospital, kuzhithurai. She explained about preventive measures of tuberculosis "prevention is better than cure". She instruct the students to follow "Healthy life style, Nutrition, Balanced diet and Immunity Boosting". She conduct a Yoga practicing for the social work and NSS students.
