BEST PRACTICE : I

Title of the Practice: Good Samaritan Scheme

Good Samaritan Scheme is a small initiative to financially support economically weaker students. Students who are unable to pay their semester and exam fees are being benefited from this scheme.

Goal

- To nurture the importance of generosity.
- To provide financial aid to the economically weaker students.
- To reinforce once personal value.

The Context

The term "Good Samaritan" refers to **a person who helps others in a random act of kindness**. Our institution started this scheme to help the poor people. In this scheme, each staff and student contribute small amount of money for every month. Good Samaritan saving money is collected through class representative and the collected money is handed over to the management for helping a student who is economically weak.

The Practice

Institution has appointed staff-coordinators from each departments to inform the names of needy students to the committee. The students, who are economically poor, ill or bedridden parents, disabled parent, orphans or has single parent, or has drunken parent who takes no care of the family then such students are selected and informed in the committee. Then the staff coordinators put marks and opt the most needy students. The money collected in a monthly basis by all the staff and students are equally divided and contributed to the selected students. In the year 2023-2024, during the month of September, 2023 Rs. 10,000 was collected and given to 2 poor students, then October,2023 one of the student was awarded with Rs. 5,000 and in the month of November Rs. 5000 was given to another needy student. While in the month of May Rs. 12000 was collected and contributed equaly to 4 students.

Evidence of Success

Many students are benefited due to this scheme. They are able to pay the exam fee or their semester fee and use the money for their health or to buy the study materials. Thus, they are able to perceive their studies without any hindrance.

Problems Encountered

• Fund received is not sufficient to help the needful students.

BEST PRACTICE : II

Title of the practice: Book Bank

The Book Bank provides books to the economically weaker students. Students who are unable to purchase new books can make use of this book bank.

Goal

- To provide higher education to all irrespective of their community, gender etc.
- To provide education to economically weaker sections of the students.
- To motivate the students to earn more marks & secure university ranks.
- To encourage the meritorious students by providing informational and educational assistance from the institution itself

The Context

Our College was established in the year 2012 with its vision and mission of striving to be a world class Institution in transforming lives of students' through an innovative, professional, compassionate approach and also to provide innovative educational opportunities to weaker and underprivileged sections of the society. So that they too can learn, grow, prosper and transform the world. Thus to make the study materials equally available for the rich as well as poor our institution has department libraries with all syllabus based book which are a great source of learning for aspiring students. Institution provides book bank facility for each department. The economically weaker students can borrow the each semester books from the book bank for free. For issuing book from the Book Bank the student have to enter his/ her name in the book bank issue register and at the end of the semester the student return it to the concerned department. In each department separate staff is monitoring the book bank. Two registers are maintained for book bank. One register shows the details of books available in book bank and another is for issuing and returning. The alumni and the final year students donate books for the Book Bank which has enriched these libraries inside the departments.

Evidence of Success

Many students are benefited from the book bank and they score more marks in university exam.

Apart from academic benefit they are inculcated with knowledge from various fields such as politics, economics, commerce, literature etc.

Problems Encountered

- At the end of the semester the final year students sometimes forget to return back the book.
- Regular usage of a particular book has damaged the papers.
- Marking and drawing on the papers.
