The candidates who qualify for the award of Junior Research Fellowship are eligible to pursue research in the subject of their postgraduation or in a related subject and are also eligible for Assistant Professor. The universities, institutions, IITs and other national organizations may select the JRF awardees for full time research work in accordance with the procedure prescribed by them.
- 7. Economically Weaker Section (EWS), Scheduled Caste(SC)/Scheduled Tribe(ST)/Persons with Disability(PwD)/ Thirdgender /Other Backward Classes -Non creamy layer (OBC-NCL), as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website: www.ncbc.nic.in, candidate will be given such special concessions as may be decided by the UGC.
- Candidates qualifying for the award of Junior Research fellowship will be eligible to receive fellowship of UGC under various schemes, subject to their finding placement in universities/IITs/institutions. The validity period of the offer is three years w.e.f. the date of issue of JRF Award Letter. However, in case the candidates who have already joined M. Phil. / Ph.D., the date of commencement of fellowship shall
- be from the date of declaration of NET result or date of their joining, whichever is later.
