1. Nanjil Good Samaritan Scheme:

The term 'Good Samaritan' refers to a **person who helps others in a random act of kindness**. The institution started this scheme to help the poor people. In this scheme, each staff and student contribute small amount of money (minimum of 1 rupee) every month. Good Samaritan saving money is collected through class representatives every month. The collected money and the contribution from the management are collectively given to the student who is economically weak.

2. Career Guidance and Motivation

The institution has a regular practice of providing career guidance and motivation to the students of Kanyakumari District. Career Guidance is a **counselling programme designed to help students to choose the right career path based on their educational qualification**. In career guidance the students receive guidance from the staff who provide expert advice on the potentials, aptitude, motivations, skills and shortcomings with the use of carefully designed assessment tools. These assessment tools are both subjective and objective. While studying the individual's interest and aptitude, the staff guide the students to set their career goals.

Apart from this, the students are given opportunities to get trained for competitive exams, Bank Coaching, Diploma in Computer courses, Driving and IGNOU Courses to build the talents of students. Thus the students are equipped with extra knowledge apart from subject knowledge that leads them to better life in society.
