


After this section, we started to visit CIF (central instrumentation facility) of IISER. The Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) of IISER, TVM houses state-of-art instrumentation for advanced characterization of molecular compounds and materials.

Following are some of the major equipments available in CIF

- Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectrometer (NMR) - Solid State 500MHz
- Nuclear Magnetic Resonance Spectrometer (NMR) - 500 MHz & 700 MHz
- Powder X-Ray Diffractometer
- Scanning Electron Microscope with EDS & WDS
- Scanning Electron Microscope with Electron Beam Lithography and EDS
- Transmission Electron Microscope - 120 KV
- Transmission Electron Microscope - 300 KV (HR) with EDS & EELS
- X-ray Photoelectron Spectroscopy (XPS)





On 21st October 2022

As a part of curriculum the department of Physics organised an one day industrial visit for the UG Physics students to the Science & Technology Museum, Trivandrum. 40 students along with 2 staff members visited the museum on 21st October 2022. The journey to the museum started at 7.30 am on the day. The team reached the centre at 10am.

First we visited Science On a Sphere (SOS) at 10.00 am. SOS is a room sized, global display system that uses computers and video projectors to display planetary data onto a six foot diameter sphere, analogous to a giant animated globe. Then we visited Planetarium at 10.30 am. After that we visited 3D theatre at 11.15 am. Students learned and enjoyed all the shows. After having the lunch, we visited the gallery and science park. The gallery has Electrical gallery, Electronics galleries, Popular Science gallery, Mathematical gallery, Mechanical gallery, Automobile gallery, Bio medical engineering gallery, Computer gallery, Solar energy gallery, and Space gallery. Different exhibits displayed in the gallery helped the students understand the various disciplines of science and technology.



Then we visited the Science park, a Mobile Science Exhibition Unit, a Play Park with Educational playing devices in the museum at around 3pm. Finally we left the museum at 4.00 pm and reached the college by 6.00 pm.


Industrial Visit Report

- X-ray Photoelectron Spectroscopy (XPS)




Industrial Visit Report
